Meeting Minutes

August 17, 2016

Prior to the meeting, members cleaned up the Alumni Park in preparation for the Friday night fish fry, and the truck and tractor pulls. The meeting was called to order at 7:27pm. Cathy Jo Schreiber summarized the minutes from the last meeting. Terry Slotty moved to accept the minutes as written. Mark Ladsten seconded the motion.

Kathy Breunig gave the treasurer's report. Scholarship account is at \$13,781.96. Supplies account is at \$2,151.35. Checking account 1 is at \$6,011.97. Checking account 2 is at \$7,426.82. Line of Credit is at 4.5%, with \$20,000 owed on it, paying \$475.75 in interest. The spring pull we took a loss of \$2,093.67 due to both nights being rained out. Income for the fall pulls from sponsors is at \$4,000.00. Jerry Keller moved to approve the treasurer's report. Terry Slotty seconded the motion.

Old Business:

Land Contract – Tim Enge

- We have an accepted offer to purchase the adjacent land to the park for \$75,000. Planned closing will be October 1st. No down payment needed and we will be getting our loan through the Sauk Prairie Community Bank.

Fish Fry and Fall Pull – Tim Enge

- Fish Fry tickets will be sold at the door for \$10 each. Pull Tickets will also be \$10 each, or people can buy both tickets for \$15. Mike Dunse will bring a roll of tickets for us to use to keep track of how many fish dinners are sold.
- Gun Raffle tickets are still for sale for \$10 each but sales are low. We will try to sell more of these during the pulls.
- Approximately \$4,800 was spent on guns and we printed 500 tickets... need to sell all 500 tickets to break even.
- Drawing will be Saturday night of the pulls at 9pm.
- Volunteers still needed for both nights.
- Saturday night pull is Badger State; our goal is to try and limit how many people are allowed in the pits for insurance reasons and safety.

Cow Chip Throw – Troy Talford

- Need a set up crew for Friday night as well as more volunteers to help sell pizzas this year.
- We will have 4 pizza ovens going at one time. Pizza is coming from Papa Murphy's. They will have a trailer for us to use to as well as a 24 pizza warmer, so hopefully we will be ready for the mad rush of sales after the parade!

- We have 125 pizzas ordered but Papa Murphy's will have 150-160 in the trailer just in case. Good news is we are not obligated to pay for these extras if we do not sell them.
- Pizza will be \$3/slice.
- Money will be combined with the FFA selling pork sandwiches.

New Business:

7th Grade Career Day – Amy Yanke

- 7th Graders will be out of school to learn about different careers in the agriculture industry
- 6 people will be needed to help serve lunch
- Amy will send out an email looking for volunteers

State FFA Alumni Convention – Kathy Breunig

- Cost is \$15/tractor and \$10/rider- this will cover each person's lunch with the remaining income being donated to the Food Pantry.

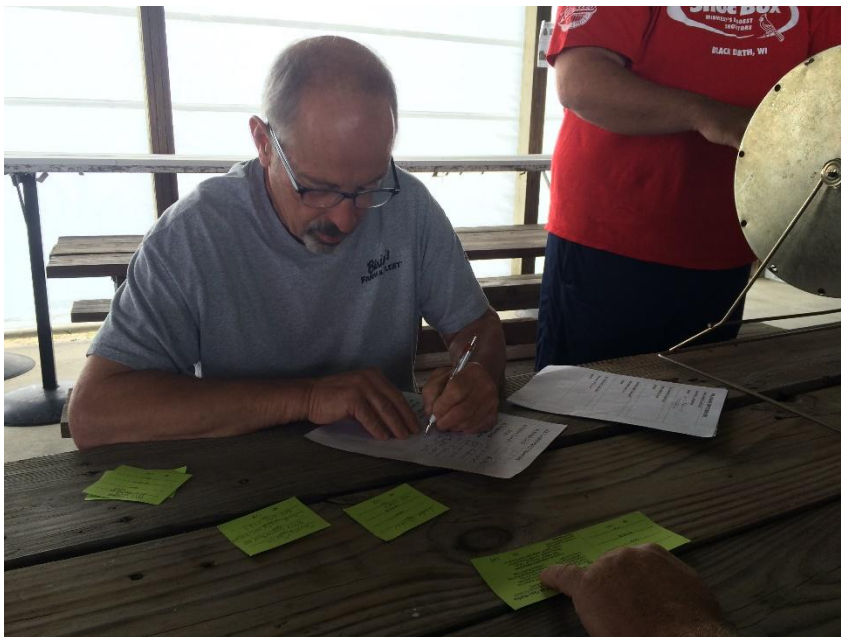
With no other new business at hand, Kathy Breunig moved to adjourn the meeting. Jerry Keller seconded the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
