Scholarship Qualifications:

- Must be a Sauk Prairie High School (SPHS) class of 2025 student, or SPHS graduate from 2022-2024
- Must be planning to work in a hands on/trade related occupation
- Must be planning on directly entering the work-force (i.e. farm, trades, CDL, etc.)
- A student is eligible to receive this scholarship the year they graduate, as well as one time, post-graduation.

Payment Information for Winning Student

Winning applicant must meet the following criteria to claim this non-renewable \$500 scholarship.

- Submit a letter on or before June 1st of 2026 (from their employer they have had for a minimum of six (6) months) stating the value the student is bringing to the company/community
- Must attend the FFA Annual Banquet (April 6, 2025) business casual or business professional attire to claim further directions for payment
