For Wisconsin FFA Talent Entries, an electronic recorded audition must be uploaded to Wi.FFA Talent Performance Drive.

Use recording equipment that is of high quality. If you are singing a solo with a band and/or using a Karaoke background, make sure the balance is such that we can hear the singing. The length of your performance (not including introductions) should be a minimum of two minutes and a maximum of four minutes (or the length of one song).

When uploading your recorded performance follow the noted template to name your file.

First Name Initial, Last Name, Chapter, Talent

**EXAMPLE:** C.Superstar.AnywhereFFA.Dance

All entries must be the work of the applicant(s) applying.

### Begin your recording following these steps:

**Step 1:** Slowly announce your name (first and last) and chapter. *If there is more than one performer, each person states their name (first and last) and chapter.*

**Step 2:** Repeat your name(s) and have one individual state the performance title.

**Step 3:** Begin your performance. Length of one song.

**Step 4:** When you are finished with your performance. Restate your name(s), chapter, and title of your performance then stop your recording.
